

OLD TESTAMENT LESSON Selections from Genesis 1 - 2:22 NRSV

¹ In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth...³ And God said, "Let there be light," and there was light. 4 God saw that the light was good, and he separated the light from the darkness... And God said, "Let there be a vault between the waters to separate water from water." ⁷ So God made the vault and separated the water under the vault from the water above it. And it was so. 8 God called the vault "sky."... And God said, "Let the water under the sky be gathered to one place, and let dry ground appear." And it was so. And God saw that it was good... 11 Then God said, "Let the land produce vegetation: seed-bearing plants and trees on the land that bear fruit with seed in it, according to their various kinds." And it was so... ¹⁴ And God said, "Let there be lights in the vault of the sky to separate the day from the night, and,...¹⁶ God made two great lights—the greater light to govern the day and the lesser light to govern the night. 
