Please remember that this event is for mom and your preschooler. This is a special time for you and your child, but please remember that space in the classroom is limited. Each preschooler may bring **one** mom (or a grandmother, aunt, neighbor, or other female adult if mom can't be there). Please plan to make other arrangements for your preschooler's siblings.

Graduation

Graduation will be held on Wednesday, May 24th for **the Multi-Age Four Year Olds, Pre-K Four and Pre-K Five Classes** at Little Hands Preschool. We will not have regular classes this day. The children are to report to their classrooms at 9:00 am. Graduation will be held in the Sanctuary and will begin at 9:30am.

The children will parade around the Sanctuary as we did for the Thanksgiving Sing-Along and the Parade of the Magi, so all aisles will need to be clear.

In order for the ceremony to run smoothly we ask that you please follow these basic rules:

- Cell phones and related electronic equipment should be turned off to ensure that all guests can hear and enjoy the commencement activities.
- During the ceremony please do not stand in the aisles or stand or sit in front of the picture taking row. This is particularly distracting to the preschool staff and the graduates.
- The first row of chairs in the sanctuary will be sectioned off for picture taking. As each class is called forward a parent may come forward to this row to take pictures.
- As a courtesy to others, after your child has crossed through the arch and is seated, please return to your chair so other parents may get a picture of their child.
- The rows of chairs sectioned off directly in back of the picture row are reserved for the graduates to sit as they come off the stage. Please do not use these rows for picture taking.
- Please return to your seat when your child's class has finished so that the parents of the children in the following class may have the same opportunity to take pictures.

- Please remember to keep your conversations confined to before and after the ceremony. Parents and other guests are excited to hear the songs being sung and their child's name being called. Please show the respect to other children that you wish afforded to your own child.

- The ceremony lasts for almost an hour. This is a long time for younger siblings to sit quietly and wait. If your child becomes restless, we ask that you please take them to the lobby and remain with them until they can get their "squirmies" out and can return to the sanctuary quietly.
- After each class has finished, they will be seated as a group with their teachers in the rows roped off immediately behind the first row of chairs and will be dismissed according to class at the end of the ceremony. Children will not be dismissed until the end of the ceremony.

Refreshments will be served in Rooms 23-27 (Triple Room).
