## Applying and Being Selected for an Emmaus Team

It is mathematically impossible for everyone to be selected to serve on an Emmaus team. Each weekend there are about twice as many new members added to the Emmaus community as are needed to serve on a future team. Those responsible for making up teams earnestly try to see that everyone has a turn, but they must work within certain guidelines (such as, at least half of the team members should have prior experience from other teams). An effort is also made to spread the team membership among various churches, denominations, and geographical locations.

In addition to these guidelines, there are other factors to consider:

You must be willing to serve in any capacity.

You must commit to being available for eight to ten team meetings, in addition to the weekend itself.

Certainly there is the joy of being on a team, but there is also the work and the strain. Team members routinely are the first up in the morning and the last in bed at night. Everyone on a team must carry their full load and be ready to pick up part of someone else's work when something unexpected happens --and it always does. Then, every team member must be ready and willing to share his or her faith and love with any other person on the weekend --at any time.

Again, the joy and the mountain top experience is there as a team member. There is also the climbing and the giving --all weekend long and during the teaming process.

Should you decide that being a team member is not right for you, there are many other areas of service in Emmaus. It takes hundreds of people to pull off a weekend. They create palanca, serve on committees, etc. There is so much to be done and that offers you many opportunities. So, being on a team may or may not be right for you. Only you know the answer.
