

GOSPEL LESSON John 1:29-42 NRSV

The next day he saw Jesus coming toward him and declared, "Here is the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world! ³⁰ This is he of whom I said, 'After me comes a man who ranks ahead of me because he was before me.' ³¹ I myself did not know him, but I came baptizing with water for this reason, that he might be revealed to Israel." ³² And John testified, "I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and it remained on him. ³³ I myself did not know him, but the one who sent me to baptize with water said to me, 'He on whom you see the Spirit descend and remain is the one who baptizes with the Holy Spirit.' ³⁴ And I myself have seen and have testified that this is the Chosen One."

³⁵ The next day John again was standing with two of his disciples, ³⁶ and as he watched Jesus walk by he exclaimed, "Look, here is the Lamb of God!" ³⁷ The two disciples heard him say this, and they followed Jesus. ³⁸ When Jesus turned and saw them following, he said to them, "What are you looking for?" They said to him, "Rabbi" (which translated means Teacher), "where are you staying?" ³⁹ He said to them, "Come and see." They came and saw where he was staying, and they remained with him that day. It was about four o'clock in the afternoon. ⁴⁰ One of the two who heard John speak and followed him was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother. ⁴¹ He first found his brother Simon and said to him, "We have found the Messiah" (which is translated Anointed). ⁴² He brought Simon to Jesus, who looked at him and said, "You are Simon son of John. You are to be called Cephas" (which is translated Peter).

- TONNECT THROUGH A SMALL GROUP FUPCDC now has 11 Small Groups (7 Men's groups and 4 Women's groups) that meet weekly (via phone) for a short devotion and prayer. - ** KAIROS PRISON MINISTRY Kairos Prison ministry is starting back up. It has made a major impact in the lives of 1000's of inmates and this congregation. FUPCDC has been involved with this ministry for more than 15 years in a variety of means in men and women's prisons in the state of Virginia. At least six inmates have given their testimonies here at FUPCDC as to the impact of this program on their lives. They are forever grateful to this congregation and the KAIROS ministry. They have given their lives to Christ have transitioned back into society and have been blessed with jobs. How can you HELP? There are several ways in which you can be a part of this ministry.
 - 1. Join the Inside Team for Sussex 1 State Prison. We will participate inside the prison on the weekend of March 30th April 2nd, 2023 (Thursday-Sunday), staying at a nearby hotel in the evenings. There will be four Saturday training sessions here at FUPCDC on February 18th, and March 4th, 18th, and 25th to prepare you for the weekend. Sam Parris will be leading the weekend inside Sussex 1 and the training sessions leading up to the weekend.
 - 2. Join the Outside Team assisting with meals, prayers and supporting the Inside Team. Cathy Albrecht and Denise Parris will be co-leading the Outside Team.
 - 3. Sign up to pray for the team and inmates (look for signups in the future).
 - 4. Sign up to bake homemade cookies that will be brought into the prison and distributed to the inmates and prison staff (look for signups in the future).
 - 5. Sign up to make placemats (drawings and scripture) This is a great project for our Children and Youth too (contact Sam Parris).
 - 6. Make a financial donation.
