In April, our preschool classes will enjoy a picnic-themed "We Go Together" unit, where they will learn that Jesus is the one friend that not only wants to be our friend forever, but He can actually keep up His end of the promise. The Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) first priority is to provide funding to these partners on the ground. While the scale of this crisis is new, receiving refugees from Ukraine and other countries in Central and Eastern Europe is not, which means we have trusted, established partners with the knowledge and expertise to carry out this important work. Our response will include both financial and technical assistance as the network of faith communities providing humanitarian assistance grows in the months ahead.
