Deacons Report - July 2018

On May 31st, the Deacons attended Luminaria Ceremony held at the church. Thanks to all who braved the bad weather to make this night memorable and heartfelt. When reported to session, a motion was made to hold a private church luminaria ceremony regardless of the outcome at the main Prince William County event. Future ceremonies would be held the last Thursday in May.

On June 23rd or July 7th, the following Deacons attended Deacon Training given by Pastor Jeri: Agnes Fokwa, Lisa Fortner, Liz Glyer, Mayra Drayer, Celine Sonkwa, and Carol Schwalm. The training is mandatory for all first year deacons. Every deacon serves a term of 3 years with an option of serving an additional 3 years.

On June 12th and July 10th, we delivered a meal to the Beverly Warren Shelter in Dumfries, Virginia, which is the second Tuesday of every month. The shelter provides a safe place to stay for the night or even a few weeks for those facing homelessness, eviction, living in a car or on the street or living in other housing which has been deemed unsuitable for human habitation.

Thank you again for all the many volunteers who stepped up to support meals for the residents of the **Hilda Barg Homeless Prevention Center Emergency Shelter** from 1-6 July, and 9-10 July. Following session approval, a signup was posted in the Narthex following both services. **Session** approval was also received to allow the local mission budget to fund pizza for the July 4th meal. Located in Prince William County, the shelter is a 30-bed shelter for families and single adults. It offers comprehensive services including case management, job readiness, mental health counseling and medical referrals. The shelter is open year-round. It takes a village. Apologies if I missed someone that made such a difference in this endeavor.




The CHRISTIAN CAREGIVING JOURNEY



Sunday, September 16th, join Pat Manalio as she begins a 9 week course on Christian Caregiving. Through speakers, various texts and written material, the entire gamete of caring for older adults (parents, siblings, spouses, friends) is explored. Unique to this course is the study of the interaction between care giver and care receiver. Focus is also given to the care giver's psyche. At each session, attendees will have the opportunity to share their stories, and gain perspective through questions. All sessions may stand alone, or the entire course may be attended.

The Horizons Bible Study is a monthly group that meets on the second Monday of the month at 9:30 AM to 11 AM in Room 22, September through May (and June if needed, due to weather cancellations). The 2018-2019 study is "God's Promise: I am with you Always" using various scriptures to look at God's promises and the many ways that God is with us. We use a variety of Bible translations as we look into the scriptures together to find God's messages for us. Books are \$11.00.

The Bible Buddies study group meets at the church on Monday nights from 7 PM to 9 PM in Room 22, beginning September 10th. This study is entitled "Who is Jesus?' and will run for about 9 weeks. (We may decide not to meet on a holiday if several people would be away.) This study begins with the four gospels, then looks at Paul's writings and the book of Hebrews plus some writings not chosen for the Bible to see who these people thought Jesus was. We will also look at Jewish and Muslim literature and contemporary writings to conclude our study. Books for this study are \$9.00.

All are welcome at both studies, even if you can't make every session. We work collaboratively as we enjoy searching God's word.
