Wilbur was raised in an Army chapel where he was exposed to many Protestant denominations, has previously belonged to the Evangelical United Brethren, United Methodist, Lutheran and Episcopal churches, but has an ancestral connection to the Presbyterian church through his mother's family which belonged to a church that was founded on the German Reformed tradition. He looks forward to further service as a Deacon at FUPCDC.
